

ORAL SURGERY PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **DAY OF SURGERY** If your surgery is scheduled for the morning, you are not to eat or drink breakfast before your appointment unless instructed otherwise by the doctor. If your surgery is scheduled for the afternoon, you are not to eat or drink anything for lunch before your appointment unless instructed otherwise by the doctor.

2. **DO NOT WEAR MAKE-UP** to your surgery appointment. Wear comfortable, loose fitting clothing such as a jogging suit, and gym shoes. Do not wear perfume or cologne to your surgery appointment.

3. **A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY YOU AND REMAIN IN THE OFFICE WHILE YOU ARE IN SURGERY AND DRIVE YOU HOME.** The vehicle must remain at the office during the procedure also. This is strictly for safety reason for the patient. You will need someone to stay with you for several hours after leaving the office.

4. **THIS IS OUTPATIENT SURGERY.** It is very important that you follow these instructions. If you have any questions, please call prior to your appointment.
